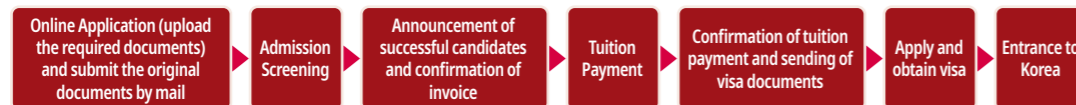

3 Entrance Process and Flight Information

- Student flight information will be provided separately after the visa is issued.
- Since it takes approximately 3 hours to go to Sun Moon University from Incheon Airport, if possible, please arrange your flight arriving time before 4pm.
- Depending on the COVID19 situation, there is a chance of being quarantined after entrance to Korea.
- After purchasing the flight ticket, make sure to forward your name (in English), gender, date of departure, time of arrival and flight number to the language institute.

4 Visa Information

- Students wishing to participate in the regular course must apply for general training (D-4-1) visa. Depending on the country, the required documents may differ, so please refer to your local Korean Embassy or consulate in advance.
- The D-4-1- visa is valid for 6 months and can be extended up to 2 years at the immigration office in Korea. After submitting the required documents (admission letter, reference letter, proof of tuition payment etc.) to the Korean Embassy or consulate, the visa will be issued after a screening procedure. Since the process of obtaining D-4-1 visa usually takes 1 month, it is advisable to start the procedure at least 2 months before the start of the semester.

- All foreign students are mandatory to apply for an insurance for traveler.
- From 6 months after entering Korea, it will be converted to the National Health Insurance
- Travel Insurance Fee: 90,000 won for 7 months
- National Health Insurance Fee: 50,000 won per month
- Textbook Expenses: Approximately 50,000 won for each Beginner/Middle/Advanced textbook.

6 Tuition Payment Method

- Students who have passed the document screening must pay the tuition by overseas remittance. The account number for paying tuition is operated by a virtual account for each student. Remittance must be made overseas through a financial institution, referring to the INVOICE send by the school. (See below for common information for overseas remittance).

7 Application Cancellation

- If students want to cancel their registration before the semester starts, they will be refunded the full tuition (class fee) except for the admission fee. However, if students drop out after the semester starts, they will be refunded in accordance with the tuition refund policy.

2 Application Process

- If COVID19 situation makes it difficult to enter Korea, you can conduct an online interview.

3 Applicant Qualifications

- Foreign students who have completed at least 12 years of elementary and secondary school and graduated(expected graduation) and both parents are foreigners(excluding multiple nationals)
- ※ However, the following cases are also exceptionally recognized.
 - a. In the case where a person who has completed more than 12 years of elementary/secondary courses in two or more countries inevitably falls short within one semester (6 months) due to differences in the school system between the countries concerned.
 - b. In the case where the school system(not recognized as the month of transfer or transfer) or early graduation system is permitted under the relevant country's education-related laws, etc., it becomes insufficient due to the monthly or early graduation of elementary, middle, and high school courses.
- Foreigners whose parents are both foreigners who have completed all the following foreign education courses recognized by the Minister of Education as equivalent to high school education
 - a. In some countries the number of years in elementary/middle/high school might differ. Regardless of the grading system, the last 3 years would be considered as high school.
 - b. If you have completed elementary/middle/high school education in two or more countries.

- All documents in languages other than Korean, English or Japanese must be notarized in Korean or English
- Students from Apostille Countries must submit their Highest level of certification together with the "Apostille confirmation", Students from non-Apostille Countries must receive a "Consular confirmation" from the Korean Consulate in the country where they attended their last school.
- Graduates(recipients) from educational institutions in China must submit- "China Higher Education Certification Report" (<http://www.chsi.com.cn/>) or "China Academic Degree Certificate Report" (<http://www.cdgd.edu.cn>)
- All documents submitted by the applicant must be originals. (If additional documents are not issued, they must be notarized and submitted.)

10 Visa Service Information

- All foreign students who passed the school admissions must acquire a D-2 (foreign student) visa.
- The standard admission permit for obtaining a visa is issued by the school, and each student must make a copy of the final academic certificate, final academic transcript, and hukou (for Chinese students), which are necessary documents for visa change in Korea.
