## The potential of the Chungcheong region is the competitiveness of Sunmoon.

### Urban Development Project in Tangjeong

With the completion of the 'POSCO The Shop' and 'Hoban Summit' residential complexes scheduled for completion in 2023 many new building are being constructed and local development is accelerating in Tangjeongsin City. In anticipation of population influx, the Tangjeong Station was opened between Baebang Station and Asan Station on October 30, 2021. Various commercial venues have been created in the Tangjeong urban area due to the development of what is known as 'new cities'. As such, the increase in the migration rate

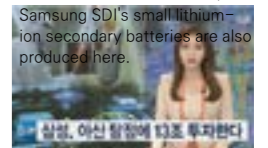


to these 'new cities' in Cheonan–Asan area and the consequent strengthening of the settlement conditions are proof of the potential of the Chungcheong region.

### Cheonan Asan KTX Valley

Cheonan and Asan area have been recognized for its potential as Korea's electronic components industries center. Planned investments are underway in preparation for this era of digital revolution, and three major ICT high value-added electronic components are produced here and supplied to the world. Accordingly, many large companies are located in this area. By 2025, Samsung also plans

to invest more than 13.1 trillion won in one of its branches namely, the 'Samsung Display' located in Asan city. Samsung Electronics' display panels and memory semiconductors, the world's No. 1 item in market share, and Samsung SDI's small lithium-ion secondary batteries are also produced here.
