

OUR LOCATION

Griffith College is located in South East Queensland, on the east coast of Australia.

We have two campuses, less than an hour apart, situated in key locations in this thriving part of the world.

Just a short distance from the city centre of Brisbane the 'River City', the capital of Queensland, is our Mount Gravatt campus, on the fringe of the scenic Toohey Forest.

Only an hour's drive south, on the free-flowing Pacific Highway, is our Gold Coast campus, within easy reach of world-famous beaches and relaxed entertainment.

The campus that you attend will depend upon the study program that you choose.

Both of the Griffith College zones are part of Griffith University's wider campus, meaning our students are part of university life from day one. Once your study is complete, the move from Griffith College to Griffith University could be a simple walk around the corner!


